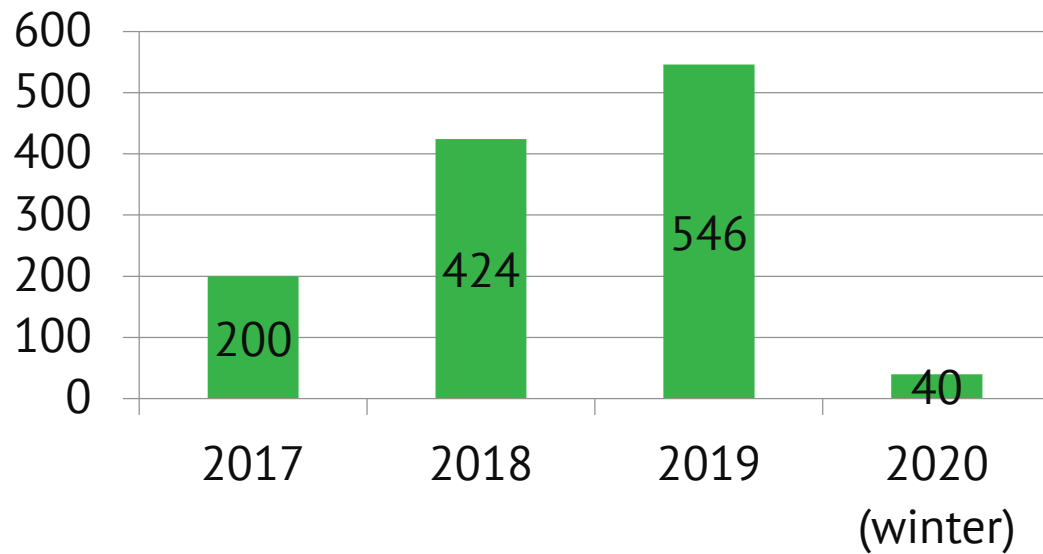

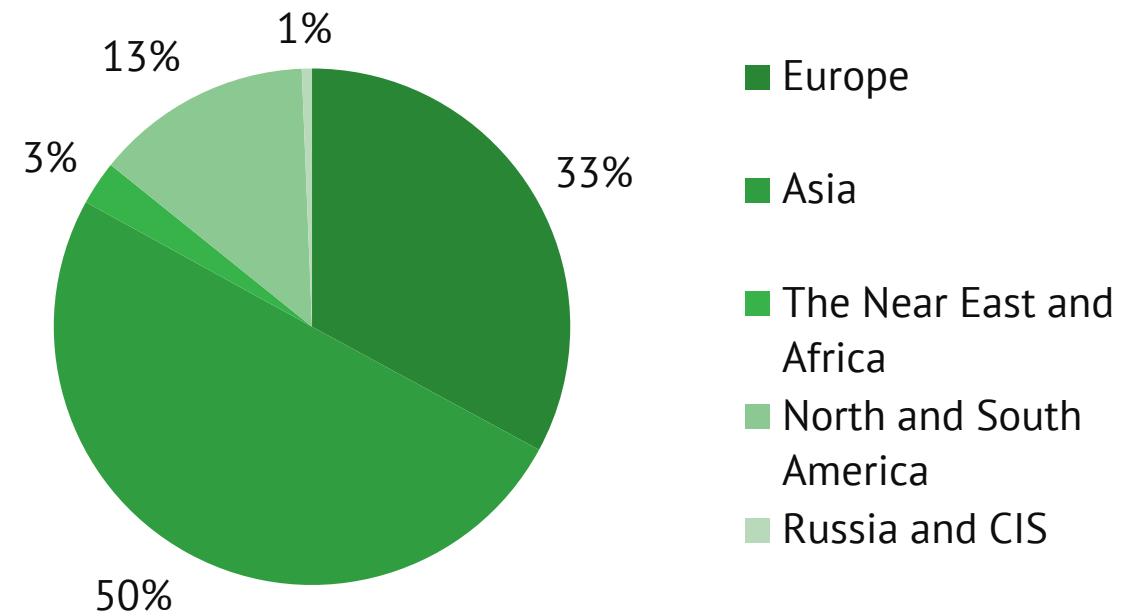

Russian language and culture. Course description

Russian language (intensive)

The course is aimed at obtaining and improving the main communication skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing. It helps to break the communication barrier and facilitates better understanding of Russian language. The students are divided into small groups according to their levels.

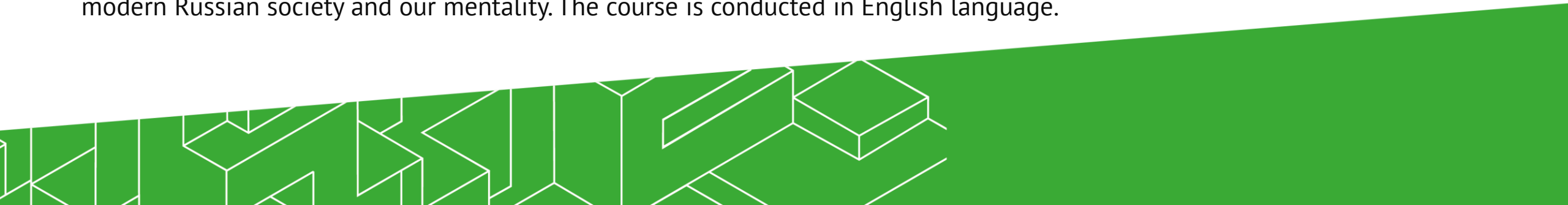
Apart from the classroom study, each week we arrange speaking clubs and social activities helping you to start talking in Russian.

Russian history and art

The course provides an overview of the progress of Russian art in a historical context, acquaints the students with principal trends of Russian art and architecture, the formation of different styles and the creations of the most remarkable Russian artists. The course is conducted in English language.

Russian Language, Politics & Art in the White Nights (session 1)

Course description

Intensive Russian language study is combined with exciting trips and excursions to the best sights of St. Petersburg and its suburbs. Apart from that, the program involves English-taught courses on Politics and History of the Russian Art covering the main stages, events and reforms of the Russian political system and providing an overview of the Russian art in a historical context.

Dates: June 10 – 28, 2019

Participation fee: 480-530 euro



Russian Language, Literature & Business Culture

Course description

This summer school offers intensive Russian language study combined with elective English-taught courses in the field of Russian Studies and exciting cultural activities. As a result, the students will obtain or considerably improve the key communication skills, feel confident about using the Russian language in a wide variety of contexts, break the communication barrier, understand the native speakers better and form comprehensive understanding of the Russian culture, literature, mentality and business environment.

Dates: July 08 – August 02, 2019

Participation fee: 480-650 euro



Russian Language for Business Communication (session 1, 2)

Course description

This intensive summer school focuses on providing the students with practical Russian language skills required for confident professional communication in a variety of business scenarios.

During the program you will increase your business-related vocabulary, improve your writing skills and learn how to efficiently put those into practice during negotiations, presentations etc. Apart from the intensive language study, you will develop understanding of the Russian business culture, work relationships and business practices in Russia, attitudes towards foreign partners and gender aspects.

Russian Language, Politics & Art (session 2)

Course description

This summer module focuses **on providing profound speaking practice**, building up your vocabulary, improving your grammar, breaking the communication barrier and increasing your confidence using Russian language in real-life situations. The program also involves the English-taught courses on Politics and History of the Russian Art covering the main stages, events and reforms of the Russian political system and providing an overview of the Russian art in a historical context.

Apart from obtaining an impressive number of transferrable credits, you will participate in diverse excursions and explore the great city of St. Petersburg, the cultural capital of Russia.

Participation fee: 480-650 euro



Intensive Survival Russian Language for Exchange Students

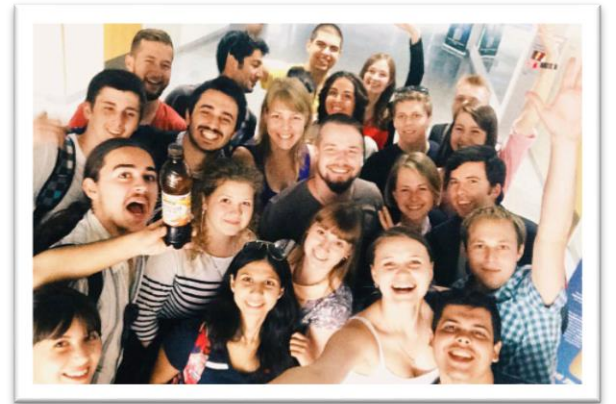
Course description

This summer school is designed for **the students of all majors arriving to the Fall semester exchange programs** or English-taught degree programs who are willing to obtain or improve their practical Russian language skills, feel more comfortable, safe and independent in everyday situations. This intensive course focuses on speaking, so that by the end of the summer school the students could communicate with the native speakers and understand them better.

If you are interested in broadening your horizons, you can also take the following elective courses conducted in English language. Those are not obligatory but provide a nice opportunity for earning extra credits (1 ECTS):
History of the Russian Art, Politics of Modern Russia.

Dates: August 05 – 30, 2020

Participation fee: 600 euro



Russian language, History & Literature

Course description

Intensive language study is combined with English-taught courses providing an overview of the main historical stages of country's development together with the analysis of the trends and problems emphasized in the Russian Literature by the world-known Russian writers as well as their correlation with the realities of the modern society.

Dates: August 19 – 30, 2019

Participation fee: 360-410 euro



Preparation for TORFL test

Course description

The students of the August and September modules of our Summer School of Russian Studies are offered a unique opportunity to prepare for a TORFL test upon completing the summer school. The program involves tutorship of the Russian language professors, analysis of the sample tests, explanation of the important requirements and assessment scales.

Dates: available for the students of august and September modules of the summer school of Russian studies

Participation fee: 230 Euro (including the TORFL exam fee)
